## INTERNATIONAL

### Thursday, April 30

8:12 AM: The US has extended the deadline for the sale of Lukoil's foreign assets for the fifth time until May 30. Previously, the deadline was set for May 1, - US Treasury Department.

8:12 AM: US Army Central Command (Centcom) has sent a request to the Pentagon regarding the deployment of Dark Eagle hypersonic missiles in the Middle East, Bloomberg.

8:12 AM: Oil prices rose more than 6% on Wednesday — to their highest level in a month, — Reuters.

12:53 PM: Israeli importer refuses shipment of allegedly stolen grain, — N12.

- The company "Centsiper", one of the largest importers of grain to Israel, informed the supplier that the cargo would have to be redirected to another port.
- The decision was made against the backdrop of increased control over "gray" grain supplies and the threat of sanctions consequences.

1:58 PM: The Russian ship with stolen Ukrainian grain has left Israel and is in neutral waters, — Ukrainian Foreign Ministry.

- The Panormitis vessel continues to sail in neutral waters, and Ukraine is monitoring its movements and calling on other states to refrain from cooperating with it.
- Prosecutor General Ruslan Kravchenko stated that Israel processed Ukrainian materials within the framework of international cooperation and recorded the fact of a violation at the international level.

3:32 PM: Ukraine called on countries to follow Sweden's example in combating the export of stolen resources from occupied territories.

- This concerns the confiscation of the Caffa vessel with Ukrainian grain.

- As stated by Vladyslav Vlasyuk, the Presidential Commissioner for Sanctions Policy, this is a significant transition from detentions to real actions within the framework of sanctions policy.

5:59 PM: Hungary has set conditions for Ukraine to join the EU, — Bloomberg.

- Hungary's new leader, the Magyar, is demanding expanded rights for the Hungarian minority in exchange for support for negotiations — Hungarian-language education and cultural rights.
- The issue was discussed with the President of the European Council, Antonio Costa — the tone of the negotiations was more negative than expected in Kyiv and Brussels.

7:11 PM: The Bulgarian parliament is proposing to cancel the 10-year security agreement with Ukraine.

- The corresponding initiative was put forward by MP Petar Petrov.
- According to him, the document was signed without the approval of parliament, which raises doubts about its legality and future consequences.

7:32 PM: Wreckage of a drone that had previously violated the country's airspace has been found in a field in Moldova.

- According to available data, the drone was detected by radar on March 30, after which it disappeared.

8:58 PM: Belgium joins the agreement to establish a Special Tribunal against Russia, the country's Foreign Ministry.

9:34 PM: The entire international jury of the 61st Venice Biennale resigned nine days before the exhibition opens.

- The reason was the decision not to consider artists from countries whose leaders the International Criminal Court has accused of crimes against humanity.
- Although the statement did not specifically name the countries, media reports suggest that it refers to Russia and Israel. The Israeli Foreign Ministry subsequently accused the jury of politicizing art and boycotting an Israeli artist.

9:51 PM: Israel stated that Ukraine allegedly did not provide evidence regarding the origin of the grain on the Panormitis vessel.

- The country's Foreign Ministry claims that Kyiv's request for legal assistance contained "significant factual gaps," which prompted the Israeli police to request additional information and evidence.

10:37 PM: Trump said that aid to Ukraine from the Biden administration is allegedly "one of the reasons" why the war is still going on.

10:58 PM: Oil prices depend on whether Trump gets enough sleep, says Slovak Prime Minister Fico.

- "When he gets enough sleep, oil goes down. When he doesn't and makes some kind of statement, prices automatically go up," he added.

11:17 PM: Trump said he is considering reducing the US military presence not only in Germany but also in Italy.

- According to him, some NATO countries allegedly did not support the United States during the war with Iran, while Washington "helped Europe with Ukraine."

11:39 PM: Trump could be nominated for the Nobel Peace Prize, — Reuters.

- According to the agency, three countries — Cambodia, Israel, and Pakistan — announced the alleged nomination of the US president.
- At the same time, the Norwegian Nobel Committee neither confirmed nor denied Trump's participation, as the lists of nominees remain secret for 50 years.

### Friday, May 1

8:05 AM: The US sent 6.5 thousand tons of weapons to Israel per day, — The Jerusalem Post.

8:05 AM: Iran to play in World Cup in USA despite tensions with Washington, FIFA says.

8:05 AM: The UAE has imposed a travel ban on citizens to Iran, Iraq, and Lebanon.

9:55 AM: Trump's statements about a possible reduction in US troops in Germany caught the Pentagon by surprise, — Politico.

- The department did not plan such changes and did not expect such statements, but they admit that they should be taken seriously.
- The day before, Trump, after a dispute with German Chancellor Friedrich Merz over Iran, threatened to reduce the American military presence in the country.

12:26 PM: Internet has been down in Iran for 1488 hours, — NetBlocks.

2:13 PM: Switzerland will allocate over \$63 million for recovery projects in Ukraine, — Ministry of Economy.

- These are projects in the fields of construction, mechanical engineering, renewable energy, infrastructure, industry, agribusiness, IT, and digitalization.

6:57 PM: Next week I will increase tariffs on imported cars and trucks from the EU to 25%, — Trump.

- "If they are produced in factories in the US, there will be no tariffs," he added.

8:41 PM: Trump again stated that Biden allegedly gave Ukraine "most of the US stockpiles."

9:43 PM: Trump told the US Congress that the war with Iran is over, — Politico.

- According to the publication, the White House outlined its position in a letter to Congress amid the expiration of the 60-day period after which military operations must be suspended without separate authorization from lawmakers.

10:37 PM: Trump's envoys are not yet traveling to Kyiv due to the stalemate in negotiations and their preoccupation with the Iran issue, — Kyiv Independent.

- According to the publication, Steve Witkoff and Jared Kushner initially planned a visit to Kyiv followed by a trip to Moscow, but the plans were postponed.
- Among the reasons cited are the lack of progress in negotiations on Ukraine, diplomatic work around Iran, and complex logistics, as it is currently impossible to get to Kyiv by plane.

## Saturday, May 2

8:04 AM: US blockade in the Gulf of Oman has reduced Iran's oil revenue by \$4.8 billion, — Axios

8:04 AM: US to withdraw 5,000 American soldiers from Germany within 6-12 months, — Reuters

8:04 AM: US warns Europe of delays in arms deliveries due to war with Iran, — FT.

8:04 AM: Trump has imposed sanctions on senior Cuban officials.

10:20 AM: The draft US budget for 2027 did not provide funding for the USAI program for Ukraine.

- During Senate hearings, Acting Pentagon Finance Director Jules Hurst confirmed that the document was missing \$400 million in aid that was previously planned to be allocated to Kyiv under the program.

11:28 AM: US approves \$8.6 billion arms sale to Israel, Kuwait, Qatar and UAE, — Reuters.

- Israel will receive 10,000 laser-guided APKWS missiles for \$992 million.
- Qatar has been granted IBCS combat control systems and \$2.5 billion in support.
- The UAE will receive 1,500 sets of APKWS precision missiles for \$147.6 million.
- Kuwait and Qatar will also receive additional components for Patriot systems to strengthen air defense.

12:31 PM: Ukraine has offered Japan cooperation in the field of drones.

- Foreign Minister Andriy Sybига stated in an interview with Kyodo News that Ukraine is ready to share combat experience in the field of drones with Japan and is open to cooperation depending on the readiness of the Japanese side.

1:48 PM: Germany will re-equip Europe's largest autoport for military needs, — Bloomberg.

- This is the port of Bremerhaven on the North Sea coast. 1.35 billion euros will be invested in the project.
- The port is being prepared to handle heavy equipment, including the transportation of Leopard 2 tanks weighing up to 60 tons, the transportation of other military equipment, and the rapid transfer of weapons to potential conflict zones.

11:50 PM: In Lebanon, Hezbollah militants destroyed an Israeli Merkava tank for the first time using an FPV drone, media reports.

7:54 PM: Czech Prime Minister Babis said he plans to meet with Zelensky on the sidelines of the European Political Community summit.

- The event will take place on May 4 in the Armenian capital, Yerevan.

8:35 PM: No peace agreement in the "military conflict" with the Russian Federation is possible without Ukraine's consent, Slovak Prime Minister Fico said after a conversation with Zelensky.

- Despite this, Fico still plans to visit Moscow on May 9.

9:41 PM: Polish Prime Minister Tusk said that NATO continues to "disintegrate," which poses a threat to transatlantic unity.

- He said the biggest threat to the alliance was not external enemies but internal disintegration. Tusk called for "everything necessary" to be done to stop this "catastrophic trend."
- The statement came against the backdrop of US President Donald Trump's announcement to withdraw some American troops from Germany.

### Sunday, May 3

8:00 AM: Iran is preparing a law to restrict ship traffic through the Strait of Hormuz. Israeli ships are planned to be permanently banned from passage, and ships from "enemy countries" will be required to pay war reparations for crossing the strait.

8:00 AM: Leading Republicans have strongly opposed Trump's intention to withdraw American troops from Germany, a key NATO ally.

8:00 AM: A man has been arrested in Austria for allegedly putting poison in HiPP baby puree and demanding 2 million euros from the company.

3:36 PM: Zelensky has already arrived in Yerevan for the European Political Community summit.

- Today, the president will meet with the prime ministers of Norway, Finland, Britain, and the Czech Republic.
- The summit itself and the continuation of official meetings will take place tomorrow.

7:24 PM: Sweden has detained the vessel Jin Hui, suspected of involvement in the Russian "shadow fleet," — Coast Guard.

- The ship was sailing under a false flag — when it was detained in the Baltic Sea, it was flying the Syrian flag.
- In addition, the Coast Guard had questions about the vessel's poor condition and lack of insurance.

7:52 PM: Oil prices will start falling within the next 3-9 months, US Treasury Secretary Scott Bessant.

8:33 PM: Iran has offered the US to end the war within 30 days, — AP.

- Among Tehran's conditions are the lifting of US sanctions, the end of the naval blockade of Iranian ports, the withdrawal of US troops from the region, and the cessation of hostilities, including Israeli operations in Lebanon.

- At the same time, the proposal does not include any clauses on Iran's nuclear program or uranium enrichment. Trump said he was considering the proposal but doubted it would lead to a deal.

9:01 PM: Zelensky and Finnish Prime Minister Petteri Orpo discussed strengthening Ukrainian air defense and a new defense assistance package.

- Finland will allocate \$300 million to Ukraine for defense support. According to the president, the funds will be directed primarily to strengthening air defense.
- The parties also discussed deepening the defense partnership, in particular a possible security agreement in the Drone Deal format and the issue of Ukraine's European integration.

9:27 PM: Iran has agreed to discuss its nuclear program in talks with the US, — Al Arabiya.

- According to sources, Tehran is ready to limit uranium enrichment to 3.5% and gradually reduce its reserves of enriched uranium.
- Iran also allegedly abandoned the demand for the withdrawal of American troops from the region and offered a gradual restoration of the Strait of Hormuz in exchange for the lifting of the US blockade.

11:45 PM: The US also canceled plans to deploy a battalion with Tomahawk missiles in Germany, — Reuters.

- The Pentagon's decision also involves withdrawing one full brigade from the country and scrapping plans to deploy long-range artillery in 2026.
- According to the publication, the missiles were supposed to strengthen the deterrence of the Russian Federation while European countries develop their own defense capabilities.

## **NATIONAL**

### **Thursday, April 30**

8:15 AM: Air defense forces neutralized 172 of 206 enemy UAVs.

- The enemy also attacked with one Iskander-M ballistic missile.
- A ballistic missile and 32 strike drones were recorded hitting 22 locations, as well as falling debris at 9 locations.

9:32 AM: Soldiers will be on the front line for no more than 2 months: Syrsky signed an order on rotations.

- Commanders are instructed to ensure that soldiers remain in positions for up to two months, with a subsequent mandatory rotation, which must be carried out no later than a month later.
- Rotations will be planned in advance, taking into account the combat situation and available forces and resources.

10:44 AM: Ukraine is clarifying the details of the "short-term silence" proposed by the Russian Federation.

- The president instructed to contact the US team to clarify what exactly was being discussed - a few hours of security for the parade in Moscow or broader agreements.
- Ukraine insists on a long-term ceasefire, guarantees of security for people, and sustainable peace and is ready to work on this in any effective format.

2:22 PM: Ukraine has received mobile F-16 simulators for pilot training, Defense Minister Mykhailo Fedorov announced.

- In addition to stationary ones, the first mobile F-16 Fighting Falcon fighter simulators have arrived. They have been adapted to Ukrainian conditions and geography.

2:56 PM: Martial law and mobilization extended until August 2, 2026 — Zelensky signed the decrees.

3:55 PM: Ukrainians are advised to have a water supply of 10–15 liters per day per person, — Deputy Prime Minister for Recovery Oleksiy Kuleba.

- He stated the risk of Russian strikes on water supply systems.

5:22 PM: Russia may demand the lifting of sanctions on individual companies or the return of banks to SWIFT in exchange for "silence," Zelensky in an interview with Bloomberg.

- Ukraine is waiting for the resumption of negotiations - there are currently no signals from either the Russian Federation or the United States.
- The invitation for Witkoff and Kushner to visit Kyiv remains valid - there has been no response yet.
- The Russian Federation seeks a "truce" until May 9 to allow the parade to take place peacefully, but Ukraine will not agree to a temporary pause as a tool of deception.

8:20 PM: RBC-Ukraine, citing a source, revealed details of possible agreements between the US and the Russian Federation regarding sanctions and a "truce."

- "They (the Russians — ed.) want to start a ceasefire at some point and try, for example, to agree on a week-long ceasefire. And in return for this, partially lift sanctions. America will receive news about silence on the front, Putin will receive a partial easing of sanctions and, accordingly, greater income. That is, in essence, such a "trade" without any security guarantees, which cannot suit Ukrainians," the source said.

11:58 PM: Ukraine is building a system to counter Russia's shadowy "grain fleet," — Zelensky.

- According to the president, these are ships transporting grain exported from the temporarily occupied territories of Ukraine.
- Zelensky also stated that Ukraine has intensified work with international partners on sanctions and recalled the situation with a ship with grain heading to Israel.

### Friday, May 1

8:06 AM: Air defense forces neutralized 190 of 210 enemy UAVs.

- 20 strike drones were recorded hitting 14 locations, as well as falling debris at 10 locations.

10:07 AM: Russia carried out a massive drone attack — civilians and infrastructure were hit, — Zelensky.

- At least five people were injured in Odessa, fires broke out in residential buildings. One person was injured in Kryvyi Rih, and energy and railway infrastructure was attacked in Kharkiv region. Strikes were also recorded in Sumy region and Zaporizhia.
- Daily attacks prove the need for increased sanctions and international pressure on Russia to force it to make real peace.

10:28 AM: The SBU and the Prosecutor General's Office announced new suspicions against Ihor Kolomoisky, media reports.

- We are talking about alleged fraud involving hundreds of millions of hryvnias worth of PrivatBank funds. We are awaiting official details of the case.

10:56 AM: Illicit weapons trafficking networks have been exposed across Ukraine: over 1,000 units have been seized.

- Law enforcement officers conducted over 180 searches in various regions and discovered 20 caches of weapons. As a result of the operation, 32 people were reported suspicious.
- The following were removed from illegal circulation:
  - ▪small arms – 154 units;
  - ▪grenade launchers, grenades and mines – 904;
  - ▪ammunition of various calibers - over 56.5 thousand;
  - ▪explosives – almost 80 kg;
  - ▪Firearm stores and accessories - 134.

11:36 AM: The SBU and the UCP exposed a businessman in fraud involving over 100 million UAH.

- According to the investigation, the former beneficiary of one of the largest banks in Ukraine, together with accomplices, withdrew over UAH 100 million in 2014 through fictitious loans and controlled companies.
- The funds were disguised as legitimate financial transactions, and some of them, according to investigators, ended up in the personal accounts of the organizers.
- The suspect has been notified of the suspicion and faces up to 12 years in prison. The investigation is ongoing.

1:00 PM: The driver of a truck crane who collided with a train this morning died on the way to the hospital, said Oleksandr Pertsovsky, Chairman of the Board of Ukrzaliznytsia.

- Earlier it was reported that the train driver died. The number of victims of the accident has increased to two. The circumstances of the tragedy are being established.

2:34 PM: Ukraine plans to close most negotiation chapters on EU accession in the next 12-18 months, Deputy Prime Minister for European Integration Kachka.

- According to him, after this, Kyiv hopes to sign a membership agreement in 2027.

3:45 PM: Army reform: payments to Ukrainian military personnel will increase significantly from June, — Zelensky.

- The minimum level should be no less than 30 thousand UAH for rear positions. For combat positions - many times more.

- For infantrymen, special contracts will be introduced with payments of UAH 250,000–400,000, depending on the performance of combat missions.

3:54 PM: Some more details of the army reform announced by the president:

- Significant increase in payments for commanders, combat sergeants and officers.
- Strengthening the contract system as a basis for stable military management.
- Transition to clear forecasting of the length of service for each soldier.
- Thanks to the extension of contracts, it is planned to launch a phased demobilization mechanism based on clear time criteria. This could happen as early as this year.
- May is the approval of all details, June is the official start of the reform.

4:04 PM: Air defense forces have neutralized 388 of 409 enemy UAVs since the morning.

- 16 strike drones were recorded hitting 6 locations, as well as falling debris at 11 locations.

5:45 PM: The State Bureau of Investigation has exposed a Territorial Conscription Commission official who was changing data in the register of conscripts.

- A woman made false changes to the registry for money. Four cases have been documented. She faces up to 15 years in prison.

6:51 PM: Ukraine has not received any proposals from Russia regarding a "truce" on May 9, - Foreign Minister Sybiga.

- "This is another attempt by the Russians to please the Americans. To show some element of 'constructivism'," he added.

7:41 PM: In May, all aspects of the army reform should be finally approved: documents, regulations, finances, — Zelensky.

- The President also announced new decisions to simplify the transfers of military personnel.

7:54 PM: New "tapes" of Mindich: the supervisory board of "Sens Bank" was formed by those involved in the "Midas" case, writes EP.

- The tapes record a conversation between Oleksandr Zukerman and Vasyl Vesely, who became an advisor to the head of Sense Bank after its nationalization.
- Previously, the interlocutors of the Ukrainian People's Party in business circles called Vesely a "supervisor" from the OP for the aforementioned bank, where "no decision was made without him."

7:58 PM: Zelenskyy announced strengthening air defense for Dnipro and Odessa.

- "There is already a solution for the Dnieper - the military command and the Ministry of Defense analyze each attack and offer a solution. For the Dnieper - additional radars, electronic warfare, additional crews. There is also a solution for Odessa - there is already a higher percentage of downings, we need an even higher one," the president says.

8:47 PM: Explosions were heard in Kharkiv and Kherson.

9:18 PM: The suspect in the murder of Andriy Parubiy pleaded guilty to the crime, but denied treason and justifying the Russian aggression, — "Suspilne".

- During a court hearing in Lviv, Mykhailo Stselnikov stated that he admitted murder, illegal handling of weapons, and calls for the overthrow of the constitutional order.
- He also stated that his action was allegedly "influenced" by President Volodymyr Zelensky, recalling the performance of "Quarter 95" in Horlivka in 2014.

9:35 PM: Ukrzaliznytsia has changed the rules for ticket refunds.

- Now the amount of compensation will depend on how many days before the flight the passenger hands in the ticket.
- The full cost will be refunded if the ticket is returned 15–20 days before departure, and if the ticket is returned less than 24 hours in advance, only the cost of the reserved seat will be compensated.

## Saturday, May 2

8:04 AM: Air defense forces neutralized 142 of 163 enemy UAVs.

- 17 strike UAVs were recorded hitting 12 locations, as well as the fall of downed ones (fragments) at 2 locations.

10:47 AM: In a week, the Russian Federation launched about 1,600 drones and almost 1,100 guided bombs into Ukraine, — Zelensky.

- The president stated that the Russians are trying to overload Ukrainian air defenses with massive attacks, so the supply of missiles for defense is critically important every day.

3:04 PM: The day before yesterday, there was quite specific activity on the border of Ukraine and Belarus, — Zelensky.

- "We are carefully recording everything, monitoring everything, and if necessary, we will react," the president noted.
- The president also announced several new sanctions packages.

3:42 PM: Zelenskyy had a telephone conversation with Slovak Prime Minister Fico.

- "It was important to hear that Slovakia supports Ukraine's membership in the EU and is ready to share its experience of accession," the president writes.
- Zelensky invited Fico to visit Kyiv and thanked him for his invitation to come to Bratislava. The leaders will likely meet in person soon.

4:46 PM: There are personnel issues that need to be resolved, Zelensky on government structures.

- "On some personnel positions, it is necessary to continue the dialogue with parliamentarians," the president writes.
- Some of these issues will be resolved at the level of Cabinet decisions next week.

5:30 PM: For the second day in a row, the Russians are attacking critical Naftogaz infrastructure, — Koretsky.

- The day before, a gas production facility in the Kharkiv region was hit - damage to equipment was recorded.
- Today, the enemy used an aerial bomb on a gas pipeline in Zaporizhia. Some consumers were temporarily left without gas.

6:44 PM: Zelenskyy imposed sanctions against former head of the Ukrainian People's Party Andriy Bohdan.

- In addition to him, Ukrainian businessman Bogdan Pukish, Russian businessman Alan Kiryukhin, and Russian Olympic sports promoters Stanislav Pozdnyakov and Mikhail Mamiashvili were also sanctioned.

7:22 PM: During April, air defense forces destroyed over 57 thousand enemy air targets:

- 69 X-101 cruise missiles;
- 7 Iskander-M/KN-23 ballistic missiles;

- 8 "Caliber" cruise missiles;
- 4 Kh-59/69 guided aircraft missiles;
- 5 Iskander-K cruise missiles;
- 4861 "Shahed", 1065 reconnaissance drones and 51110 UAVs of other types.

7:29 PM: Air defense forces have neutralized 220 of 227 enemy UAVs since the morning.

- 7 strike drones were recorded hitting 6 locations, as well as falling debris at 5 locations.

7:41 PM: Marta Kostyuk wins WTA 1000 tournament in Madrid

9:18 PM: Interceptor drones are now destroying about 40% of all air targets, — Deputy Commander of the Air Cover Forces Cherevashenko.

- "Last year we had a slightly higher participation rate. Now these statistics continue to grow again, because the weather is stabilizing. We have also optimized the radar field, which improves the work of the UAV interceptor crews," he noted.

### Sunday, May 3

8:08 AM: Air defense forces neutralized 249 of 268 enemy UAVs.

- The enemy also attacked with an Iskander-M ballistic missile.
- A ballistic missile hit and 19 strike UAVs were recorded at 15 locations, as well as the downing of downed UAVs at 1 location.

5:42 PM: Footage from the future: a heavy Ukrainian drone with a machine gun attacks enemy position

- "After the shot, empty magazines are dumped. The manufacturer was not found, it is probably a product of a brigade or corps," writes Advisor to the Minister of Defense Serhiy "Flash".

6:24 PM: Yesterday a hot air balloon flew from Belarus to Ukraine, — spokesman for the State Border Service of Ukraine Demchenko.

- "In fact, this is a repeater to amplify the signal for the air weapons that Russia uses against Ukraine during shelling," explains Demchenko.

7:34 PM: Air defense forces have neutralized 175 out of 234 drones and 5 out of 5 Kh-59/69 missiles since morning.

- In addition, the enemy used two Iskander-M ballistic missiles.
- The attack continues, there are several dozen enemy UAVs in the airspace.

## Thursday, April 30

9:07 AM: Explosions were heard in Dzerzhinsk, Nizhny Novgorod region of the Russian Federation - after that, smoke rose above the area of the explosives plant.

- Explosions were also heard in Perm, where the day before, on April 29, a linear production and dispatching station came under attack by the SBU.

9:53 AM: The Ukrainian Navy struck Russian boats guarding the Kerch Bridge.

- On the night of April 30, the Ukrainian Navy forces struck the FSB patrol boat "Sobol" and the anti-sabotage boat "Grachonok".
- These vessels are part of the coast guard and were used to protect the Kerch Bridge and counter sabotage operations.

10:10 AM: Primary oil refining facility on fire in Perm, Russia

12:33 PM: Large-scale fire in Perm after attack on Lukoil oil pumping station.

- The flames are spreading to the tanks, the situation remains complex.

1:10 PM: Drones from the Alpha Special Operations Center have struck oil infrastructure near Perm (over 1,500 km from Ukraine) for the second time in recent days, — SBU.

- This is one of the largest refineries in the Russian Federation with a capacity of about 13 million tons per year. It was previously reported that the AVT-4 primary processing unit was damaged and a fire broke out at the facility.
- Also, according to the SBU, the Perm linear production and dispatching station, which provides oil supplies to the refinery, was hit again.

- After the fire was extinguished, four large fuel tanks were completely destroyed, as well as the damaged technological infrastructure of the enterprise.
- The images also show damage to smaller reservoirs.

- According to the publication, at least 21 facilities were attacked in a month, including refineries, marine terminals, and oil pipelines.
- Due to repeated strikes, in particular on the Tuapse refinery, oil refining in Russia has fallen to a multi-year low.

3:10 PM: Defense forces hit several Su-57 fighters and a Su-34 fighter-bomber, — General Staff.

- The targets were located about 1,700 km from the state border - at the Shagol airfield in the Chelyabinsk region.

4:56 PM: General Staff confirms repeated strikes on Tuapse and Perm refineries

- The AVT-4 primary oil refining unit was damaged, resulting in a fire.
- In addition, it has successfully affected:
- "Buk-M3" air defense system in the vicinity of Olkhovatka, Donetsk Oblast;
- ammunition depots in Donetsk and Luhansk regions;
- warehouse of material and technical resources in the vicinity of Melitopol in Zaporizhia;

- UAV warehouse in the area of the distant Belgorod region of the Russian Federation;
- enemy UAV control points in Zaporizhia, Donetsk and Kherson regions.

5:15 PM: Russia has banned the import of satellite terminals, including Starlink, for six months — media.

- The purpose of the ban is to "protect national security" of the Russian Federation.

6:23 PM: SBS commander releases footage of attack on fighter jets at Russian airfield "Shagol"

- Four Russian aircraft were hit at once - two Su-57 fighters, a Su-34 fighter-bomber and an aircraft of unknown modification.
- The cost of one Su-34 is \$35-50 million, and the Su-57 is \$100-120 million.

7:26 PM: Destruction of "Akhmat": GUR soldiers conducted a unique special operation in the Sumy direction

- The intelligence officers recruited an ex-military "Akhmat" - he installed a listening device right in the room where the unit commanders met.
- The information received allowed Ukrainian special forces to target Kadyrov's supporters during their movements and in areas of concentration.
- As a result, within two months, "Akhmat" suffered its greatest losses since the beginning of the war: 41 killed and 87 wounded.
- More than a hundred mercenaries are listed as missing. A significant amount of enemy equipment, communications equipment, electronic warfare/electronic warfare equipment, and weapons and fuel depots have been destroyed.

11:13 PM: In April, Russia occupied 11.9% less territory than in March, despite a 2.2% increase in the number of assaults, — Deep State.

- The largest enemy advances were recorded in the Donetsk region — 53 sq km, which is almost half as much as in March. Active fighting also continued in the Sumy, Kharkiv, and Zaporizhia regions.
- At the same time, the Defense Forces of Ukraine have reduced the area of occupation in the Dnipropetrovsk region from 187 to 98 square kilometers over the past three months.

11:39 PM: More than 5,000 foreigners recruited into the Russian army died in the war against Ukraine, according to the State Defense Committee.

- According to the Ukrainian side, since 2022, Russia has recruited at least 27,000 foreigners from over 130 countries, as well as about 14,000 military personnel from the DPRK.
- The GUR notes that foreigners are often lured with promises of civilian work, but upon arrival in the Russian Federation they are sent to the front for "meat assaults."

- The organizers of the scheme are named as a Territorial Conscription Commission instructor, his former colleague, and the deputy director of the enterprise. The men were detained while accepting a bribe and face up to 10 years in prison.

8:05 PM: An explosion was heard in Bila Tserkva near the Territorial Conscription Commission building, local media reported.

- According to preliminary information, the man allegedly threw a grenade, and law enforcement officers are working at the scene.
- There is currently no official information regarding the circumstances of the incident.

8:43 PM: Kyiv Region Police confirmed an explosion near the Territorial Conscription Commission building in Bila Tserkva.

- According to law enforcement, a local resident threw a grenade and has already been detained.
- Police and the Security Service of Ukraine are working at the scene, there are no injuries.

- The most damage was recorded in the Primorsky district of the city. High-rise buildings, private houses, a kindergarten, a shopping center, a hotel, and administrative buildings were damaged here. Dozens of buses and cars were destroyed or damaged in several parking lots.
- In the Khadzhibey district, hits were recorded on infrastructure facilities, warehouse buildings, and a garage cooperative.

9:25 AM: The number of victims of the night attack on Odessa has increased to 20, — Regional Military Administration.

- Among them are citizens aged 17 to 70. Two of the injured are in serious condition, and doctors are providing them with all necessary medical assistance.

1:58 AM: Explosions are heard in Odessa.

3:38 AM: An explosion was heard in Izmail, Odessa region.

5:26 AM: The Russian Federation attacked the port infrastructure of the Izmail district, the Izmail Regional Air Defense Agency reported.

- "As a result of the attack, a fire was recorded in a 16-story building. We also have another high-rise hit - a fire broke out there on the 11th and 12th levels," the report says.
- Information about the victims and the extent of damage is being clarified.

1:34 PM: In the afternoon, Russia launched a drone strike on the Odessa region, — Regional Military Administration.

- The attack damaged the roof of the shopping center and caused a fire that has since been extinguished.
- Fortunately, there were no injuries.

### Saturday, May 2

6:31 AM: Russians again attacked the port infrastructure of Izmail in the Odessa region, — Izmail Regional State Administration

- At the same time, they added that the air defense forces worked very effectively, so there was almost no destruction.

3:01 PM: 12 years have passed since the tragic events at the Trade Union Building in Odessa.

- As a result of clashes between pro-Ukrainian and pro-Russian activists, about 50 people were killed there, and another 250 were injured.

- According to the investigation, a 48-year-old serviceman was riding a bicycle, stopped near a Territorial Conscription Commission and police vehicle, then took an object resembling an automatic weapon out of his bag and opened fire.
- After the attack, the man fled, but law enforcement officers found and detained him. He is being charged with attempted murder and desertion.
