I thought about this when I heard the announcement that Putin was coming to Alaska to meet with President Trump to discuss the fate of Ukraine.

At 12:30 into this discussion between Jason Jay Smart of the Kyiv Post and former Navy SEAL Chuck Pfarrer Smart, in a question posed by Pfarrer, said that he wouldn't be surprised if Putin didn't show up in Alaska, instead sending a body double. To support his argument, Smart cited Japanese intelligence that, based on facial recognition, and voice recognition software that evaluates differences between how people pronounce certain words, Putin body doubles have been used before. In the last day or so, the White House has started to downplay what the “meeting” might achieve, calling it a “listening exercise.” Maybe the House knows something. After all, what else can be accomplished, other a “listening exercise,” if one of the principals isn't even present?

The Pessimism Issue

As long-time readers of these emails know, we constantly ridicule what our former Vice President and master of alliteration, Spiro Agnew, might've called the “Purveyors of Pessimism,” including what we have derisively called the “Newspapers of Record,” consisting of the Washington Post, NY Times and the Wall St. Journal, White House officials going back to Obama Administration, TV News shows like “the Newshour,” and any number of thinktanks. They're at it again, fueled by dire predictions of the outcomes of the “meeting” in Alaska, combined with the recent Russian incursion.

The pundits like to point out that Ukraine is fighting two enemies, Russia and corruption inside Ukraine. Add a 3rd – the Purveyors of Pessimism. The latest object of their pessimism is the recent Russian incursion toward the Ukrainian city of Dobropillya. In the 11 years since Russia's illegal annexation of Crimea, the Purveyors of Pessimism is the 3rd enemy encountered by Ukraine. The thinktanks and the newspapers of record file

reports and stories, the TV news shows invite the authors of the reports and stories on to their shows, and it all contributes to public policies toward Ukraine articulated by the White House and by some (I repeat SOME) members of Congress and their aids.

Pushing back against the Purveyors of Pessimism is a mission of not just by us, but by the Kyiv Post and a few others. I've been itching to write about the pervasive pessimism surrounding Ukraine, but who am I? Fortunately, someone with more credibility than us has stepped forward, Minna Alander of Chatham House in an article appropriately entitled, "[Pessimism as a Self-Fulfilling Prophecy](#)." Some excerpts:

- "While the danger of being overly optimistic is to be negatively surprised by developments you had not seen coming and therefore did not prepare for, **pessimism can very easily turn into demoralising defeatism, if no credit is ever given where it is due. This is a particular responsibility for elites: political leaders, journalists, and analysts alike.** The publics, in the best case, tend to trust what they say and form their own view of a probable future based on their assessments." (my emphasis)
- "Ukraine is perhaps the best case in point on how expectations can be proven wrong: even in the period leading up to the 2022 full-scale invasion, [Ukrainian willingness to resist and fight](#) was at 59 percent somewhat below the OECD average. But once the onslaught began, the whole society mobilised."
- "Ukrainians have shown what a level of creativity lack of options in an existential emergency can unleash. People also usually don't fight for a leader - Ukrainians don't fight "for Zelensky" - but for their homes, way of life, and a better future."
- "Ukrainian civil society powerfully demonstrated this in the [recent protests](#) against the controversial attempt at eliminating political independence of Ukraine's anti-corruption agencies."

In the Spring of 2022, the Purveyors of Pessimism were proven dead wrong about Ukraine's prospects, when Ukrainians drove the Russians away from the approach to Kyiv. Did they admit they were wrong? No. Instead, over the next 3+ years they've doubled down, and it is why a few of us are still "here."

Meanwhile, on the Battlefield

The Dobropillya Incursion should be put in the context of what else is happening, which is something that Denys Davidov has in my opinion failed to do in his latestg "[Latest Denys:](#)"

- The aforementioned [Kyiv Post Interview](#) providing a convincing argument about why Russia is losing the war.
- No one has asked the question of how the Dobropillya Incursion can be sustained without armor and artillery support. According to Ukrainska Pravda, over the last 24 hours Russia has lost only 5 tanks, 5 armored personnel carriers and 26 artillery pieces throughout Ukraine. Dobropillya is a Russian incursion led by small infantry units.
- With all due respect to Denys Davidov, as Wall Street Journal Foreign Editor Yaroslav Trofimov stated in his recent podcast entitled "[Putin Has No Chance of Breaking Ukraine's Front Line.](#)" He prefaced his remark by stating that this is subject to the flow of Western weapons continuing.

And there is this, "[Ukraine Won't Surrender, with Adrian Karatnycky and Tim Mak](#)" / David Frum Show – "The Atlantic"

Adrian Karatnycky is a long-time analyst of events in Ukraine.

- In the 33rd minute in this video Karatnycky says that the Republican Party rank & file still supports Ukraine, after continuing attacks on Ukraine by Turker Carlson and others.
- In the 34th minute Karatnycky points out that Europe is investing billions into Ukraine's defense infrastructure as well as its own.

- In the 40th minute Frum asked Karatnycky about the prospect of Ukraine surrendering. He said that given Europe's new support that there is no prospect of Ukraine surrendering (We've said the same thing, absent the prospect of Europe's support). Karatnycky went on to say that the one area where Ukraine hasn't attacked, that could force a change, is attacking the Russian energy grid, especially around Moscow & St. Petersburg, either by drones, missiles or sabotage, likely all 3.
- In the 43rd minute, Tim Mak said that he doesn't think that either Russia, or the US, or both, can "force" Ukraine into an unfavorable peace. He cited a joke, "As long as there is a 12-year-old kid in Ukraine with a plastic fork that there will be resistance to Russia, and Russian occupation.
- At 45 minutes, Adrian Kaeatnycky argues that there is no political faction in Ukraine that would be willing to play ball with Russia, in a Russian occupation of Ukraine. He says that today is the "high point" of Ukrainian unity.

All this leads back to the question – why have the meetings in Alaska at all? Or, if President Zelenskyy had been there, he might ask a similar question to President Trump as the woman asked by friend, how long HAS it been since you lived in Alaska?

INTERNATIONAL

12:58 AM: The White House is considering inviting Zelensky to Alaska, where Trump plans to meet with Putin next week.

- This was reported by NBC News with reference to a high-ranking US official.

1:57 AM: The head of the European Commission and EU leaders on the eve of the meeting between Trump and Putin called to protect the key security interests of Ukraine and Europe.

- The joint statement emphasizes that negotiations are possible only if hostilities are stopped or reduced, and the path to peace cannot be determined without the participation of Ukraine. The EU also confirmed the inadmissibility of changing international borders by force and stated that the current front line should be the starting point for negotiations.

8:04 AM: The White House is currently not planning a three-way meeting between Trump, Putin and Zelensky, — Reuters, citing a US administration official.

8:04 AM: As a result of the "exchange" that Trump talked about, Ukraine will probably receive only small sections of occupied border territories in the Sumy and Kharkiv regions, CNN.

9:51 AM: Meaningful talks can only take place if there is a ceasefire or a reduction in the intensity of hostilities. The path to peace in Ukraine cannot be determined without Ukraine, the joint statement of the leaders of the countries on the eve of Trump's meeting with Putin.

3:22 PM: There are mass protests in Israel against the plan to completely take over Gaza.

- About 100,000 people took part in the rally in Tel Aviv. People demanded an end to the war in the Gaza Strip and the return of all Israeli hostages.
- "This is not just a military decision. This can be a death sentence for our loved ones," said the wife of one of the hostages.

4:51 PM: EU foreign policy chief Kaia Callas will convene a meeting of EU foreign ministers on August 11 to discuss the next steps for the Trump-Putin summit, Reuters.

- She stated that any agreement between Washington and Moscow on ending the war in Ukraine should include the interests of Ukraine and the EU. This will be the key topic of the meeting.

5:21 PM: "No big chunks or areas will just be given away unless they were fought for or won on the battlefield," US Ambassador to NATO Matt Whitaker said of Ukraine's territorial concessions.

5:36 PM: "We have finished financing the military business in Ukraine. We want to reach a peaceful settlement," JD Vance said.

- Other statements of the US vice president:
- The US is planning when Putin and Zelensky can sit down and discuss ending the conflict;
- A meeting between Putin and Zelensky before the talks with Trump would not be productive;
- The US seeks a settlement in Ukraine, taking into account the current line of confrontation;
- The states will continue the dialogue with Ukraine and Zelenskyi.

5:56 PM: "I want to be honest with you. Ukraine is not going to drive out all the Russians. And Russia is not going to go to Kyiv. Eventually there will be an exchange of territories," Senator Graham said.

- "The third war can be stopped by continuing to arm Ukraine so that the Russian Federation is restrained by the most powerful army in Europe at the moment, which is Ukraine," he added.

6:11 PM: There is a possibility that Volodymyr Zelenskyy could join the Trump-Putin summit in Alaska, US Ambassador to NATO Matt Whitaker said.

7:25 PM: Baku will consider lifting the arms embargo on Ukraine if Russia continues to strike Azerbaijani energy facilities in Ukraine.

- This is reported by the mass media with reference to sources.

8:55 PM: Trump's meeting with Putin in Alaska will be a kind of "test" of the Russian dictator, NATO Secretary General Mark Rutte said.

- According to him, the purpose of the negotiations is to find out how serious Putin is, but there will be no final agreement for Ukraine this time.

9:37 PM: Ukraine will continue to receive weapons from NATO regardless of the results of the summit in Alaska, - Mark Rutte, Secretary General of the Alliance.

- He emphasized that the supplies will continue so that Ukraine has everything it needs to fight and be in the best position when the time comes to negotiate a ceasefire or a peace agreement.

9:57 PM: A powerful 6.1 magnitude earthquake struck Turkey's Balikesir province, destroying residential buildings.

- One house completely collapsed, about ten were damaged. Tremors were felt in Bursa, Yalova and Istanbul.
- There are victims, rescuers are sorting through the debris and looking for people.

11:01 PM: In Poland, a member of the Seimas from the "Law and Justice" party, Matetsky, said that he would contact the prosecutor's office because of the unfurling of the OUN-UPA flag at Max Korzh's concert in Warsaw.

- The incident took place at the National Stadium, where one spectator raised a UPA flag with a trident, another a blue-yellow flag with the "Idea Nation" symbol. Matetsky considers this a violation of Article 256 of the Polish Criminal Code.

NATIONAL

8:14 AM: Air Defense forces neutralized 70 out of 100 enemy drones.

- 30 drones were hit at 12 locations in Dnipropetrovsk region, Kharkiv region, Sumy region, and Chernihiv region, as well as falling debris at 3 locations.

11:53 AM: Foreign Minister Andriy Sybiga urged partners not to make any concessions to Russia.

- "No rewards or gifts to appease the aggressor. Only strength and unity can force Russia to stop the war. Every concession provokes further aggression. That is why Ukraine firmly stands by its principles and values," the foreign minister emphasized.

8:36 PM: Russians across the front continue to take lives in frontline communities, and no deadlines will stop them, Zelenskyy said.

- "Everyone sees that there is not a single real step by Russia towards peace, not a single step on the ground or in the air that could save life. That is why sanctions are needed, pressure is needed," the president added.

11:27 PM: Since the beginning of the day, 112 combat clashes took place on the front, in particular, the enemy attacked 32 times on the Pokrovsky direction, 18 on the Novopavlivskiy, and 11 on the Lymanskyi.

Details: On **North-Slobozhansk and Kursk** two attacks by Russian invaders took place in these directions. The enemy carried out nine air strikes, dropping 17 guided bombs, launched 275 attacks, including eight from rocket salvo systems.

On **Yuzhno-Slobozhanskyi** direction, Ukrainian troops repelled four enemy attacks in the Vovchansk region.

On **Kupianskyi** the enemy made five attacks in that direction. Fighting took place in the areas of Radkivka, Kindrashivka, Petropavlivka, and Stepova Novoselivka settlements.

On **Lymansky** direction, Russian troops stormed the positions of Ukrainian defenders 11 times in the areas of the settlements of Karpivka, Kolodyazi, Grekivka and in the direction of Shandrygolovoy and Dronivka.

On **Seversky** direction, Ukrainian soldiers repelled five offensive attempts. Units of the occupiers tried to advance near Hryhorivka, Vyimka, and Verkhokamyanskyi.

On **Kramatorsk** direction, the Defense Forces stopped three enemy attacks in the areas of Novomarkovo, Chasovoy Yar, and towards Bila Hora.

On **Toretskyi** In this direction, the occupiers stormed the defenders' positions eight times in the areas of the settlements of Diliivka, Toretsk, Oleksandro-Kalynove, Katerynivka, and in the direction of Rusyny Yar and Pleshchiivka. The defense forces restrained the onslaught of the enemy and repelled all assaults.

On **Pokrovsky** direction, the enemy made 32 attempts to suppress Ukrainian units. The greatest activity is observed in the areas of Poltavka, Volodymyrivka, Zatyshok, Kucheriv Yar, Zapovidne, Krasnyi Liman,

Myrolyubivka, Sukhetske, Chunyshyne, Zvirove, Kotlyna, Horikhove and Fedorivka settlements. Two clashes are still ongoing.

According to preliminary calculations, in this direction, Ukrainian soldiers eliminated 108 and wounded 56 occupiers, destroyed eight units of motor vehicles, 13 unmanned aerial vehicles and a warehouse of ammunition; also damaged three guns, two cars and a tank of the invaders.

On **Novopavlovskiy** direction, the enemy tried to break through 18 times near the settlements of Zeleny Gay, Vilne Pole, Temyrivka, Myrne, Oleksandrograd, Voskresenka, Shevchenko and Olhivske. Battles continue in four locations.

On **Gulyaipilskiy** direction, in the Malinivka area, Ukrainian defenders stopped the attack of the invaders.

On **Orihivskiy** direction, the invading troops attacked in the Kamiansky area.

On **Prydniprovskiy** direction, the enemy launched four futile attacks on the defenders' positions.

11:50 PM: Finnish volunteer Markus Mattsson covered 2,350 km from Helsinki to Kyiv to raise funds for the Armed Forces.

- His route passed through Estonia, Lithuania, Poland and the Ukrainian cities of Lviv and Ternopil. During the 27 days of the bicycle marathon, he raised 10,000 euros for tactical medicine.

MORDOR – ruZZia

6:09 AM: A refinery is on fire in Saratov, Russia, after a drone attack.

8:39 AM: Russia is transferring significant forces to the Zaporizhzhia and Pokrovsky directions, Andryushchenko, head of the Center for the Study of the Occupation, said.

- A large-scale transfer of equipment to the Zaporizhzhia direction was recorded. This is the biggest increase since July-August.
- Tanks, armored personnel carriers and guns were also moved from the Berdyansk direction to the north of Donetsk region. Separately, the transfer of units ranging from a brigade to a regiment from the Crimea was noted.

12:39 PM: the Kremlin does not plan to hand over the captured districts of Kherson Oblast and Zaporizhzhia Oblast, — WP.

- According to the publication, Russia maintains these territories as a key land corridor to the occupied Crimea and is not ready to give them up.

1:46 PM: Defense forces attacked the Saratov oil refinery, the General Staff of the Armed Forces confirmed.

- After the impact, explosions and fire were recorded.
- The enterprise is one of the key objects of the fuel infrastructure of the Russian Federation, which supplies oil products to the occupying forces. Its annual capacity is up to 7 million tons of oil.

4:07 PM: Drones first flew to the Ukhta district of the Komi Republic, which is 2,000 km from Ukraine.

- Russian media reported that loud explosions were heard in the area of the local oil refinery. They write about a hole in the tank.

7:51 PM: Today, the LUKOIL-Ukhtaneftepererabotka refinery was hit as a result of a special operation by the GUR, RBC sources.

- The affected facility participates in supplying the occupying army with fuel and lubricants.
- The drones hit a tank with petroleum products, spilling the contents and damaging a gas and gas condensate processing plant. In addition, in the city of Ukhta, the electricity and the Internet disappeared.

11:22 PM: the Russians have published footage of PTM-3 anti-tank mines being dropped from Shaheds.

- Two KPTM-3 cassettes with mines with a magnetic detonator, which react to nearby equipment, are attached to the drone.

REGIONS

10:19 AM: This morning, a Russian drone hit the roof of the Regional Military Administration building in the center of Sumy.

- There are no casualties. Locals are urged to stay away from government buildings and critical infrastructure during air alerts.

10:59 AM: The Armed Forces of Ukraine liberated and completely cleared the settlement of Bezsaliivka of the Sumy Region, the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine, from Russians.

- Units of the 33rd separate assault regiment and the 24th separate assault battalion were involved in the operation. During the hostilities, Ukrainian soldiers eliminated 18 Russian invaders.

7:03 PM: An explosion is heard in Sumy.

1:12 AM: Explosions are heard in Kharkiv Oblast.

2:19 PM: The Armed Forces of Ukraine advanced to the southwest of Kindrashyvka in Kupyan Oblast, — ISW.

- Analysts of the institute do not confirm the statements of Russian bloggers about the capture of the railway station to the northeast of the city, as well as about the advance in Vovchansk, Vovchanskyi Khutor, Ogirtsevo, Gatyshchi and Liptsy.
- No enemy ground activity was recorded in the Velikoburlutskyi direction and northeast of Borova.

10:20 PM: The Armed Forces destroyed the equipment and manpower of the occupiers in Kharkiv Oblast

- The operators of FPV drones eliminated the camouflaged tank and self-propelled guns, hit the armored personnel carriers, cars and buggies, and destroyed the enemy group in an ambush with a control strike.

3:27 PM: Air forces of the Armed Forces of Ukraine carried out a successful bomb attack on the command post of the occupiers' battalion in the Oleshok area, — General Staff.

- Previously, about 25 occupiers were eliminated, at least 11 were injured.
- According to intelligence, among the dead are the commander, the chief of staff, the chief of the engineering service, and the commander of one of the battalion's platoons.

6:06 PM: Explosions are heard in Zaporizhzhia.

6:19 PM: As a result of the Russian attack on Zaporozhye, two people were injured, Regional Military Administration.

- The transport infrastructure object was hit.
- The number of victims increased to 3.

7:02 PM: The number of victims as a result of the attack on Zaporozhye has increased to 9, — Regional Military Administration.

- the Russians attacked the central bus station. The search and rescue operation continues.
- The second blow was inflicted on the clinic of Zaporizhzhya Medical University. There were no casualties.

7:34 PM: In Zaporizhzhia, the number of wounded as a result of an enemy attack has increased to 12, — Regional Military Administration.

8:03 PM: The number of wounded as a result of the Russian attack on Zaporozhye has increased to 19, the head of the Regional Military Administration, Ivan Fedorov, said.

- Among them are men aged 24, 38, 39, 41 and 56 and women aged 25 and 77. Doctors assess their condition as moderate, they are all being treated.
- PS: As a result of the impact, seven apartment buildings and non-residential premises were damaged. Buildings have broken windows and damaged roofs.

9:11 PM: Surveillance cameras captured the moment of the attack on Zaporozhye in broad daylight.

- "This is terror. And we must call everything by its name. Russians terrorize our people and the whole of Ukraine every day," wrote the head of the Regional Military Administration, Ivan Fedorov.

10:36 PM: Emergency and rescue work at the site of the shelling in Zaporizhzhia has been completed, the State Emergency Service reported.

- As a result of the attack, 20 people were injured, one of them was unblocked from under the rubble.

12:29 AM: Explosions are heard in Dnipropetrovsk region.

9:43 AM: At night, the Russians destroyed the train station in Sinelnikovo, Dnipropetrovsk region, — local channels.

- There is destruction at the transport company. 2 private houses were mutilated. The city also partially lost light.

11:11 AM: As a result of shelling in Dnipropetrovsk region, several trains are delayed - "Ukrzaliznytsia".

- Traffic on the section between Dnipro and Zaporizhzhia is carried out under an auxiliary locomotive, the delay is up to one hour.
- Trains No. 92 Odesa — Kramatorsk and No. 824 Dnipro — Kharkiv detour through the Samar-Dniprovskiyi station. Restoration work is ongoing.

1:30 PM: Defense forces control Dachne in Dnipropetrovsk region, General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine.

- The military denied rumors about the occupation of the settlement. The defenders hold their positions, causing significant losses in manpower to the enemy.

12:11 PM: A mine detonated near the shore in Zatoka, local channels.

- In advance, the dead are reported.

12:57 PM: The mine explosion in the Gulf occurred due to swimming in the restricted area.

- The military was told that people ignored safety rules and entered the water in a place unsuitable for recreation. As a result, they exploded on explosive objects.
- In Odesa and the region, there are officially 32 safe swimming zones that have been tested for the absence of mines. The command urges to rest only in authorized places.

1:26 PM: Three people died as a result of explosions on the beaches of Odesa, Regional Military Administration.

- A man and a woman blew themselves up while swimming in Zatoka, another man — in Karolino-Bugaza.
- "This once again proves that staying in untested water areas is deadly," the report said.

2:42 PM: The Navy appealed to the Ukrainians after the death of three people in Odesa.

- The military is urged not to approach unknown objects in the water or on the shore and not to ignore prohibition signs or warnings.

- In case of detection of suspicious objects, inform the relevant services.

6:12 PM: A man with a gun took people hostage in the "Arsen" store in Lviv, media outlets.

- The police are on site.
- Previously, there was a conflict between two men. The law enforcement officers have already detained the man, Deputy Zinkevich said.

7:41 PM: Regarding the situation in the "Arsen" supermarket in Lviv:

- The police reported that the 36-year-old man was not armed and had no prohibited items on him. He had a conflict with a security guard and is currently detained.
